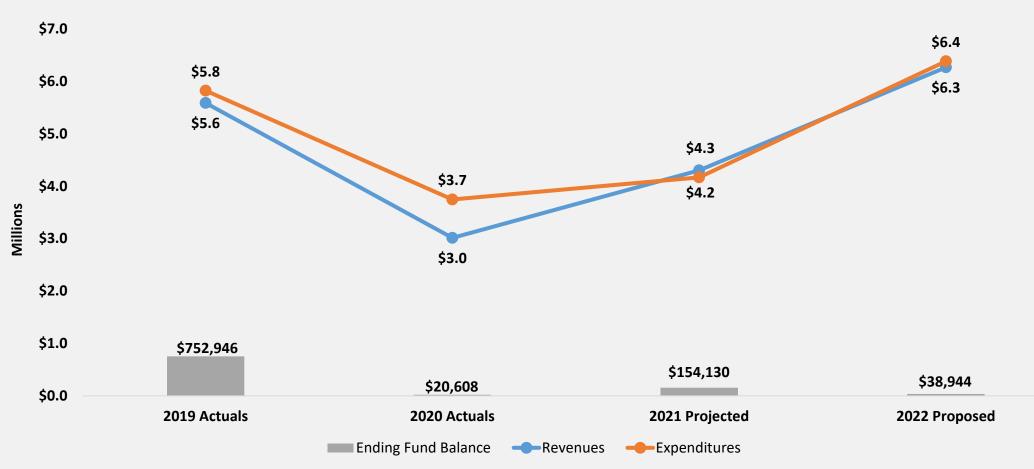

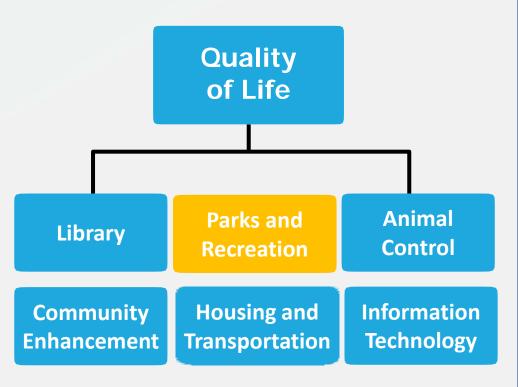




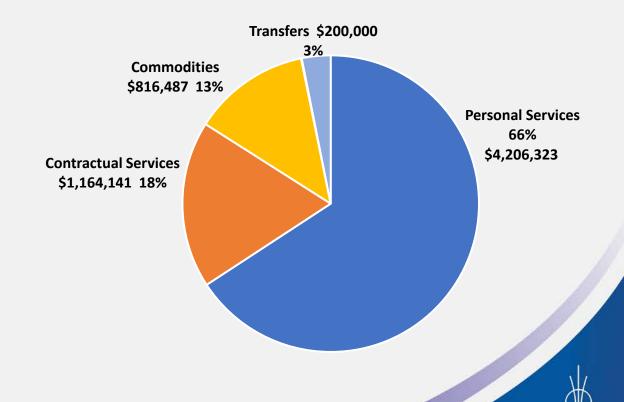

- Make improvements to outdoor pools, beach, and marina.





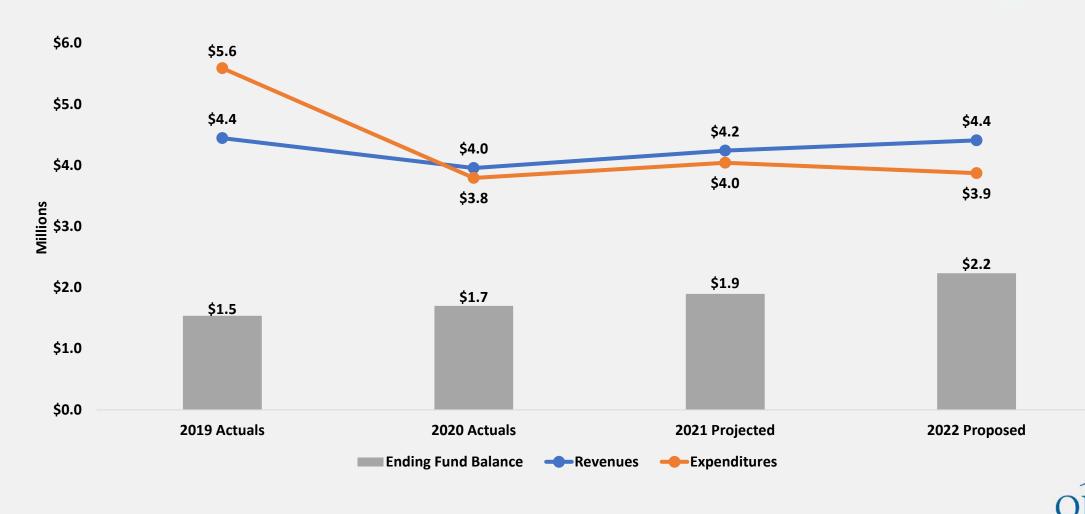

Park Sales Tax Fund (FY 2019-2022 Proposed)

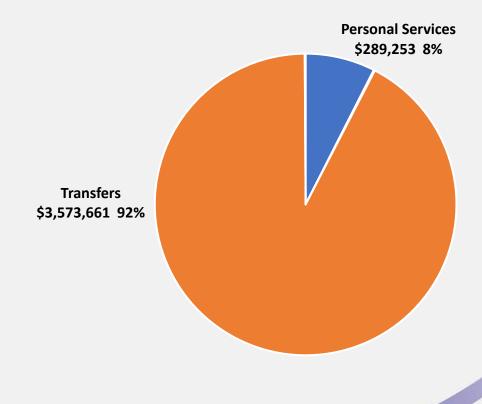

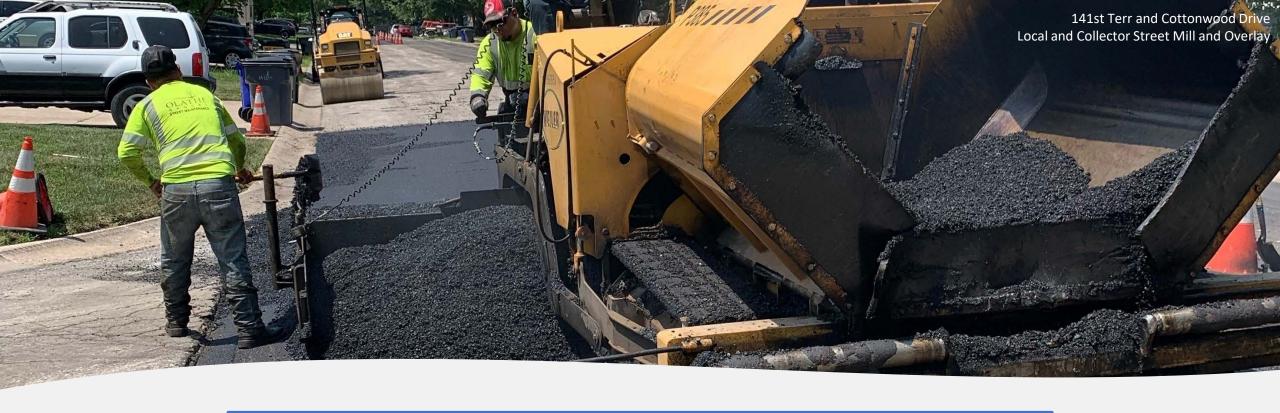

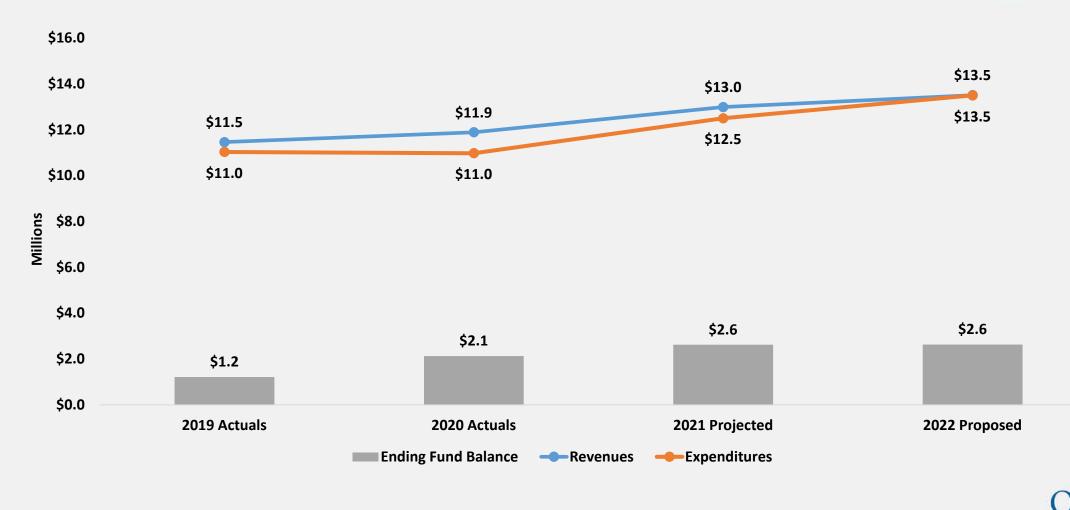

Street Maintenance Sales Tax Fund (FY 2019-2022 Proposed)



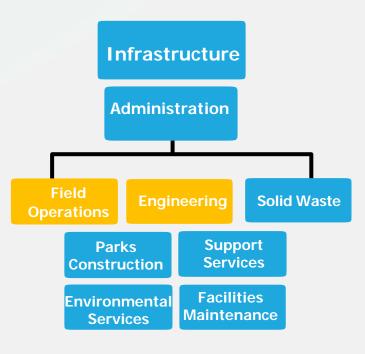

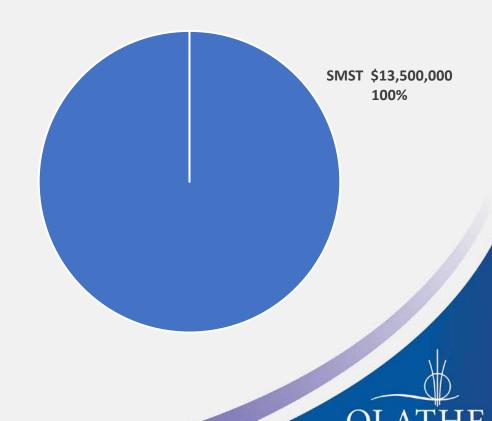


Street Maintenance Sales Tax Fund

2022 Goals

- Continue to improve the overall condition of streets from 77 to 81-84 overall condition index (OCI).
- Prepare and share information on the past benefits and continued need for Street Maintenance Sales Tax renewal.
- Complete 28 lane miles of arterial mill and overlay, 36 lane miles of collector mill and overlay, and 70 lane miles of surface treatment.
- Complete over 45,000 square yards of base and curb repair, 250 lane miles of crack seal, and 25,000 feet of curb and gutter replacements.
