community center Alcohol Policy



The serving or consumption of wine, beer or liquor on the premises is allowed under the following conditions:

- Alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises during private party rental events. All city, county and state of Kansas laws pertaining to the serving of alcohol, including beer and wine, must be strictly followed. Serving alcohol to any person under the age of 21 is illegal and will not be tolerated.
- The serving, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises may be ordered discontinued at any time at the discretion of the City of Olathe staff. Inappropriate behavior, exposure to liability due to excessive drinking, intoxication of individuals, damage to property or injury to individuals and other such activities will result in the closing of the bar and the discontinuance of the serving, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- Any function where alcohol is served will require a Security Officer at the cost to the rental client. The Community Center will schedule a Security Officer at a fee of \$40 per hour. The security officer must be on-site from the time the alcohol service begins until the end of the contracted time.
- Security Officer is present to enforce Community Center rules and regulations. Neither the Security Officer nor the Center is personally responsible for the conduct of event guests.
- No alcoholic beverages will be allowed outside designated areas of the community rooms, kitchen, and patio.
- Alcohol service is prohibited for events comprised mainly of guests eighteen (18) years of age or younger.
- No exchange of money for alcohol is allowed.
- Bartender tips are acceptable.
- Alcohol may not be consumed on the premises if there is no security guard present. This applies to pre-event setup and preparation time. The client is responsible for informing all members of their party and vendors of this policy.
- Alcohol service must cease at least 30 minutes prior to the end of the contract time for alcohol service less than 3 hours. Events with alcohol service 4 hours or more, service must cease at least 1 hour prior to the end of the contract time.
- Individuals/Guests are not allowed to bring in their own alcohol.
- All alcohol must be provided through the client, caterer, or bartending service.
- Alcoholic beverages cannot be self-service.
- The client is responsible for acquiring the services of a professional bartender.
- The client will provide bartender name and contact information prior to the event date.
- The bartender must meet the following requirements:
 - Must be 21 years or older
 - Cannot consume alcohol while serving as bartender
 - Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to service
 - Supply photo ID
 - Review, sign and follow the Alcohol Service Guidelines
