

Swap Your Stuff: Holiday Edition Guidelines

Items We Cannot Accept

- Full size Christmas trees (mini trees are okay)
- Old/Vintage incandescent string lights
- Items of unreasonable size (ex. Large plastic outdoor statues, rooftop décor, etc.)
- Items that are broken/dirty or otherwise unusable
- Any hazardous items

Examples of Acceptable Items – Can be for ANY Holiday

- Wrapping supplies (wrapping paper, tissue paper, gift bags/boxes, bows, gift tags, ribbon, etc.)
- Decorative wreaths or swags
- Decorative signs, banners
- String lights – battery operated, electric, LED, etc. (MUST be in working order, no frayed/bare wires, broken bulbs, etc.)
- Knick-knacks
- Tableware (unused disposable or reusable) -tablecloths, mugs, napkins, serving platters, candy dishes, place mats, etc.
- Stationary – unused holiday cards, Valentine’s cards, envelopes, stamps, stickers, etc.
- Candles – battery operated or wax, candle holders/warmers, menorahs, etc.
- Tree toppers, skirts, and ornaments
- Garland/greenery
- Pet items – costumes, dog bandanas, clothing, etc.
- Holiday crafting items – fabrics, ribbon
- Decorative throw pillows/pillowcases
- Baking items (non-food, holiday themed only) - cake pans, cupcake liners, cookie cutters, aprons, utensils, etc.)
- Books, movies, music, or games (holiday themed only)
- Stockings/stocking hangers
- Easter/Halloween baskets
- Window clings, classroom/teacher decor
- Storage containers – wreath holders, ornament storage, etc.
