

**ORDINANCE NO. 24-43**

**AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE OLATHE PROCUREMENT POLICIES;  
AMENDING SECTION 3.50.050 AND REPEALING THE EXISTING SECTION.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OLATHE,  
KANSAS:**

**SECTION ONE:** Section 3.50.050 of the Olathe Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**“3.50.050 Procurement Less Than \$100,000.**

The City Manager will adopt operational procedures for procurement of supplies or services having an aggregate value of less than \$100,000. Such operational procedures must provide for obtaining adequate and reasonable competition and for making records to properly account for funds. ~~For procurement of supplies or services having an aggregate value of between \$50,000 and \$100,000, the City Manager must use the procedures of Section 3.50.030, unless alternative procedures are authorized by this chapter.~~ A report detailing procurement between \$50,000 and \$100,000 will be submitted to the Governing Body on a quarterly basis, post award.

For any price agreement the City enters into, the aggregate value will be considered the amount authorized for purchases under the price agreement for a single year, even if the price agreement is a multi-year contract. For the purposes of this section, “price agreement” means a contract that establishes an agreed-upon cost for supplies or services and other terms and conditions under which such supplies or services may be purchased but does not itself include a specific purchase of or order for such supplies or services.”

**SECTION TWO:** Existing Section 3.50.050 is hereby repealed.

**SECTION THREE:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
