## EXPLOSIVE PERMIT PROCEDURES

### **FOR ALL EXPLOSIVE PERMITS:**

**Contact ATMOS ENERGY if blasting within 300' of any Atmos Energy pipeline or facility 10 days prior to blasting. For their permitting requirements contact:

### **FOR OVERNIGHT STORAGE: ALL STEPS**

**A.** Obtain and complete the Kansas State Fire Marshal Explosive Storage Site Permit.

Contact them at 785-296-3401 to schedule an inspection of your site.

**B.** Contact the City of Olathe Fire Administrative Offices for an inspection of your site 913-971-7900. (72 hour advance notice).

**C.** Once both signatures have been obtained, signifying the site has been inspected and approved by city and state officials, you may apply for an Explosive Permit through the Olathe Fire Department. Bring items listed on checklist below with you to the office when applying for permit.

### **FOR DAY DELIVERIES: (No overnight storage)**

**A.** Contact the City of Olathe Fire Administrative Offices for an inspection of your site 913-971-7900. (72 hour advance notice). Bring items listed on checklist below with you to the office when applying for permit.

- Blast Site Application and Inspection Checklist
- The returned State Application for Explosive Storage Site Permit. (if applicable)
- Current certificate of liability insurance with the City of Olathe,  
P O Box 768, Olathe KS 66061 listed as a certificate holder.
- Copy of ATF blaster's permits.
- Copy of State blaster's permits.
- Copy of Individual blaster's permits
- Copy of valid driver's license
- A scale map or blueprint clearly indicating blasting area, surrounding  
land, magazines, roads and all structures.
- On company letterhead, submit a letter stating that pre-blast surveys have  
been completed for structures within 600' of blasting area or a letter stating  
there are no structures within this area.

- A public notification letter shall be sent to those residents/businesses within 1500 feet at least 10 days prior to blasting. A copy of the notification and letter, including a list of addresses shall be submitted to this office.
- Permit fee of \$125.00 per site per permit for 90 day period.
- ATMOS ENERGY approved Blasting Plan if blasting within 300' of Atmos Energy pipelines or facilities. Ten (10) day prior notice required.
- Current Kansas One Call locate request # \_\_\_\_\_. Locate request MUST be for blasting entity.
